WORK SESSION

April 30, 2014

The Board of Harvey County Commissioners met in special work session on April 30 with all three Commissioners present. Chairman Krehbiel called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.


Mike King, Kansas Secretary of Transportation & Director of Kansas Turnpike Authority, met with the commissioners to discuss the proposed Harvey County communication system upgrade to an 800 MHz system, and the county's request for KDOT funding participation. He presented maps of current KDOT system coverage and discussed possible solutions to achieve the goal of 100% Harvey County 800 MHz coverage, and to fill in gaps in their system at the same time. He stated that KDOT is interested in assisting in the negotiations and possible funding participation for co-locating equipment on existing structures, such as the tall towers in Reno County.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.


