

MINUTES OF BOARD OF HARVEY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
SPECIAL MEETING
February 5, 2014

During the morning of February 5, 2014, Commission Chairman Ron Krehbiel issued a call for a special meeting of the Board of Harvey County Commissioners at the request of Commissioner Hague and Commissioner Westfall. However, due to significant snowfall and a home furnace failure, Chairman Krehbiel was unable to attend the special meeting in Newton.

Absent Chairman Krehbiel, the special meeting convened at 1:16 p.m. in the showroom of Hague's Paint & Decorating, 709 N. Main, Newton, Kansas with Vice-Chairman Randy Hague and Commissioner George A. "Chip" Westfall present. County Administrator John Waltner and Assistant County Administrator/Finance Director Anthony Swartzendruber were also in attendance. Vice-Chairman Hague called the meeting to order and opened discussion to consider authorizing publication to solicit bids for the construction of the Burmac Road Bridge over the Little Arkansas River in Harvey County.

Following brief discussion Vice-Chairman Hague moved and Commissioner Westfall seconded the motion to authorize publication for two consecutive weeks of the request for bids to construct said bridge. Bids are to be received in the Harvey County Administration Office until 10:30 a.m. on March 3, 2014, and will be opened in the Commissioners' Room of the Harvey County Courthouse at 10:30 a.m. on March 3, 2014. The motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the board, the meeting was adjourned at 1:22 p.m.


