

**MINUTES OF**  
**BOARD OF HARVEY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

**November 9, 2007**

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-3104 the Board of Harvey County Commissioners, acting as a Board of Canvassers met at 9:00 a.m. on November 9, 2007 to canvass the votes cast in a USD #373 General Obligation Bond Issue Election conducted by mail ballot in Harvey County on November 6, 2007. The following were present:

The Election Officer presented the returns of the election on the following proposition:

Shall Unified School District No. 373, Harvey County, Kansas (Newton), issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$29,910,000 to pay the costs to: (i) construct, furnish and equip additions and make renovations to portions of the existing Newton High School and Newton High School Vocational Buildings; (ii) construct, furnish and equip a new vocational building to be located at the Newton High School site; (iii) construct, furnish and equip additions and make renovations to portions of the existing Santa Fe Middle School; (iv) construct, furnish and equip additions and make renovations to portions of the existing Chisholm Middle School; (v) construct, furnish and equip an addition and make improvements to the existing Northridge Elementary School; (vi) construct, furnish and equip an addition and make improvements to the existing Educational Technology Center; (vii) construct and equip an addition and make improvements to the existing Cooper Early Education Center; and (viii) make all other necessary improvements appurtenant thereto; all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.*; K.S.A. 25-431 *et seq.*; K.S.A. 25-2018(f); K.S.A. 72-6761; and K.S.A. 75-2315 *et seq.*?

The Board proceeded to canvass the vote and found the results of the election on the proposition to be as follows:

Whereupon the result of the vote was determined, and the returns from the election were approved, the election returns were finalized upon a motion by Commissioner Krehbiel, seconded by Commissioner Roberson. Passed unanimously.

Commissioner Krehbiel made a motion to declare December 24, 2007 as a paid holiday for Harvey County employees. Commissioner Roberson seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m. upon a motion by Commissioner Roberson, seconded by Commissioner Krehbiel. Passed unanimously.
