March 5, 2019 Special Election – USD 206**

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters of Harvey County, Kansas, are open during regular office hours at the following places:

At 5 p.m. on the 12th day of February 2019, the books for registration of voters of Harvey County, Kansas, for the March 5 USD 206 Special Election will close and will remain closed until the 6th day of March 2019.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards, or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes twenty-one (21) days prior to every election.

When a voter has been registered according to law, his registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

- (1) The voter changes name by marriage, divorce or legal proceeding.
- (2) The voter changes residence.

If any of the above has occurred, you must re-register. Registration forms are available at all of the places listed above and on our website at: www.HVcoKSvote.com.

Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County Election Officer to be registered. Application forms shall be provided by the County Election Officer upon request in person or in writing by an individual applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
