
1st...Bloomfield Carillon Concert. & Join us for a trip to a Bloomfield Caril-

Personal Appointment Transportation— Personal appointment transportation is available five days a week, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Seats are filled on a first call - first serve basis with reservations taken up to one year in advance. Trips are available to Wichita, Halstead, Hutchinson, Newton, or other places in the area. At least 24-hour notice is required for reservations; so make reservations as soon as possible. Cost is ... \$20 round-trip out of county, \$12 within Harvey County and \$8 in Newton*. *Wheelchair clients only for Newton-to-Newton trips. Call for information on reduced fares.
