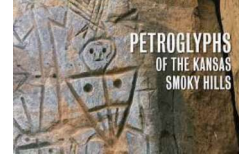

Harvey Interurban operates wheelchair accessible vehicles for shopping, personal business, and recreational trips. Trips are open to **ALL** Harvey County residents. Call 284-6802 or 866-680-6802 for information/reservations. Trips depart from the 100 block of East 6th St. in Newton, (across from Newton Area Senior Center) unless otherwise noted. For those needing transportation to the departure point, an additional fee will be charged. Reservations are “first call – first serve” and must be made at least 24 hours in advance.

3rd..Petroglyphs of the Kansas Smoky Hills. ♿ Too often Kansas history

seems to start with Coronado’s trip through the state in 1541. For centuries before European arrival, Native people lived on the plains, and some left behind rock carvings on soft sandstone in the middle of the state. Based on the book *Petroglyphs of the Kansas Smoky Hills* (University Press of Kansas, 2019), this presentation by Rex Buchanan, former director of the Kansas Geological Survey and the author of books about Kansas geology and water, focuses on these carvings, the people who made them, and what the carvings tell us about those people and their relationship to the land. The presentation also discusses the challenges of dating and interpreting these carvings, the threats posed by erosion and vandalism, and the role of landowners whose property shelters these carvings. This presentation in Whitewater is free and open to the public.

AVI Route-Tuesdays: ♿ This service for Burrton, Halstead, Sedgwick, Walton and Hesston runs each Tuesday from 12:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. The service provides general public transportation to Newton. The charge for the AVI Route is \$6. Call 284-6802 or 866-680-6802. Please call a minimum of 24 hours in advance.

Personal Appointment Transportation— Personal appointment transportation is available five days a week, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Seats are filled on a first call - first serve basis with reservations taken up to one year in advance. Trips are available to Wichita, Halstead, Hutchinson, Newton, or other places in the area. At least 24-hour notice is required for reservations; so make reservations as soon as possible. Cost is ... **\$20** round-trip out of county, **\$12** within Harvey County and **\$8** in Newton*. *Wheelchair clients only for Newton-to-Newton trips.
