Harvey Interurban operates wheelchair accessible vehicles for shopping, personal business, and recreational trips. Trips are open to **ALL** Harvey County residents. Call 284-6802 or 866-680-6802 for information/reservations. Trips depart from the 100 block of East 6<sup>th</sup> St. in Newton, (across from Newton Area Senior Center) unless otherwise noted. For those needing transportation to the departure point, an additional fee will be charged. Reservations are “first call – first serve” and must be made at least 24 hours in advance.

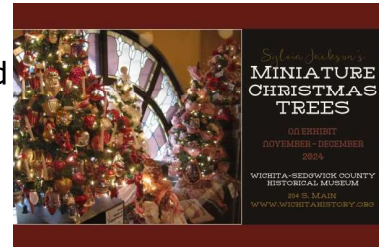
**9th...Starry, Starry Night.** ♿ Experience the night sky with the Cosmosphere from atop beautiful Coronado Heights! Timed shuttle rides to and from Coronado Heights are free and available on a first-come, first-serve basis. A wristband is needed to ride the shuttle and can be obtained at the Sundstrom Conference Center’s South Lobby starting at 5:00 p.m. Access to Cosmosphere telescopes is limited to those with wristbands to ensure the best planetary viewing and to keep the event safe. Additional events of the evening include *Glories of Our Night Sky: Wonders and Worries*, from National Geographic Photographer, Jim Richardson, at the J.O. Sandstrom Conference Center. All events are free.



Depart at 4:00 p.m. from Newton Area Senior Center. You may want to eat a bit before leaving though there are various places to grab a bite including Subway. Beginning in the 1970s, with the creation of two Victorian-style trees for her sons, the collection has grown. **AVI Route-Tuesdays:** ♿ This service for Burrton, Halstead, Sedgwick, Walton and Hesston runs each Tuesday from 12:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. The service provides general public transportation to Newton. The charge for the AVI Route is \$6. Call 284-6802 or 866-680-6802. Please call a minimum of 24 hours in advance.

**Personal Appointment Transportation—** Personal appointment transportation is available five days a week, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Seats are filled on a first call - first serve basis with reservations taken up to one year in advance. Trips are available to Wichita, Halstead, Hutchinson, Newton, or other places in the area. At least 24-hour notice is required for reservations; so make reservations as soon as possible. Cost is ... **\$20** round-trip out of county, **\$12** within Harvey County and **\$8** in Newton\*. \*Wheelchair clients only for Newton-to-Newton trips.
