

PROCLAMATION OF A
STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY
FOR HARVEY COUNTY, KANSAS

COVID 19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of March, 2020, the Chairperson of the Board of County Commissioners of Harvey County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Harvey County, Kansas resulting in potential or occurring pandemic known as COVID 19, in Harvey County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Harvey County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Chairperson of the Board of County Commissioners of Harvey County, Kansas:

That the Chairperson of the Board of County Commissioners of Harvey County, Kansas, under and by virtue of the authority vested in it by K.S.A. 1976 SUPP. 48-932, does hereby PROCLAIM that a State of Local Disaster Emergency exists.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED that the area within the border of Harvey County, Kansas covered by this proclamation/resolution is the entire area of Harvey County, Kansas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Chairperson has all rights and/or powers to perform functions as are vested in said Chairperson by and through the provisions of the Kansas Emergency Preparedness Act of 1975.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED that the state of local public health emergency in Harvey County, Kansas declared on the 31st day of March, 2020, shall continue and remain in effect until 60 days unless terminated earlier; and

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Harvey County, Kansas and shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under; and


That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law for 60 days unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.

THEREFORE, the Chairperson of the Board of County Commissioners of Harvey County, Kansas so declares on this 31st day of March, 2020, that a disaster has occurred.
